"Slow Fashion" can and should be created respecting the environment, without using plastics or derivatives, with biodegradable materials, no waste, reusing them before they are discarded. We try as hard as possible to have local suppliers, promoting green trade and industry around us. The DLABUELA project is the example of these good practices.

We take over from our grandmothers in the Axarquía region of Málaga, from their love and respect for nature while we see our world through the eyes of a child who wants to improve the environment where he/she lives. This is what guides us when creating DLABUELA textile accessories with our hands and in an artisanal way.

We use jute because it is a 100% ecological, biodegradable, and recyclable fiber. Each hectare of jute plants consumes 15 tons of carbon dioxide, releasing 11 tons of oxygen into the atmosphere. It is a plant that actively and passively contributes to improving the environment.

Organic cotton is another of our favorite materials, because -as no type of pesticide or toxic chemical is used for its cultivation and manufacture- it is recommended for sensitive skin and ideal for babies with atopic skin. At the same time, it respects the environment and the communities that grow them through a fair trade that certifies (Global Organic Textile Standard) of our cotton.
